## **SUMMER CAMP ENROLMENT CONDITIONS**

### **PAYMENT**

- Fees are payable by bank transfer or bank card. Commissions will not be applied by Caxton College.
- The total amount for the course is to be paid at least four weeks before the course begins.
- Students must arrive the night before the start of the course. There will be an extra charge of 37 € per night if the student arrives earlier.
- No discount will be given in the case of holidays or illness.

### **CANCELLATION**

- All Cancellations must be **notified in writing** to Caxton College.
- If a cancellation is made at short notice (a week or less before the course is due to start), the school **will refund 75%** of the fees paid.
- **No refund** will be made once the course and accommodation period has started. Only in the case of special circumstances will a refund be considered.

### **INSURANCE**

- Students are not insured by Caxton College against illness, accident, theft, damages or loss of personal items. The school cannot assume responsibility in the case of such occurrences.
- We strongly recommend that all students get **full private insurance** (travel, property loss, etc).
- **All students need medical insurance which should cover all possible emergencies.** Ensure that you bring all the necessary documentation with you.

*You should also check if your country has any health insurance agreements with Spain. If this is the case, you should obtain all forms and documentation before leaving your country.*

*Students from the European Community need to bring their European Health Insurance Card. Students from **outside the European Community** should have an international health insurance policy that is valid for Spain.*

### **PERSONAL DISCIPLINE**

- Students should **respect the basic rules** in regards to both the course and accommodation.
- In the case of **serious misconduct**, the student may be requested to **leave immediately**, in which case no refund will be made. Expatriation costs will be assumed by the student. The school will be the sole arbiter of what constitutes a serious misconduct. All students adjudged guilty of serious misconduct will be required to pay for any damages caused.
